Minocqua Police Activity Report April, 2017

Incidents:

During the month of April, 2017, the Minocqua Police Department handled 426 incidents with an additional 399 calls for service from the public which involved dispatching Woodruff Police Department, fire and EMS. The 426 incidents also include calls self-initiated by officers of the Department. This compares with 467 calls for service during April 2016; 400 calls for service during April, 2015; 474 calls for service during April, 2014; 490 calls for service during April 2013; 496 calls for service during April 2012; 440 calls for service during April, 2011; 555 calls for service during April 2010; and 519 calls for service during April 2009. I have attached a Minocqua Police Department Case Status and Disposition Summary which shows a breakdown of investigations opened since May of 2011 as a result of reported crimes and the current status of the case. The Department currently has 26 open investigations since the implementation of the new records keeping system in May of 2011 which are actively being investigated at this time.

Other:

On April 1st, the Department participated in the Only Fool's Run at Midnight event. Officers of the Department provided traffic control along Old Hwy 70 Road, Dr. Pink Drive and Lakeview Drive for the event. The event ran smoothly.

During the week of April 10th, the Department conducted interviews to fill the Community Service Officer and a part time Tele-communicator positions which are currently vacant. The Department conducted 7 interviews and identified two eligible candidates to move on in the hiring process. Those two eligible candidates are currently in the background investigation phase of the hiring process. The Department hopes to fill the vacant positions prior to Memorial Day weekend.

On April 26th, the new squad had decals installed.
