Minocqua Police Activity Report May, 2017

Incidents:

During the month of May, 2017, the Minocqua Police Department handled 509 incidents with an additional 356 calls for service from the public which involved dispatching Woodruff Police Department, fire and EMS. The 509 incidents also include calls self-initiated by officers of the Department. This compares with 556 calls for service during May 2016; 400 calls for service during May, 2015; 474 calls for service during May 2014; 490 calls for service during May 2013; 496 calls for service during May, 2012; 440 calls for service during May 2011; 555 calls for service during May 2010; and 519 calls for service during May 2009.
